

Refugee resettlement update

Between 11 and 14 June 2018, 36 Namibian refugees went through a series of medical check-ups as procedure before resettlement to the United States of America (USA) later in the year as part of the UN Migration Agency's Refugee Resettlement and Migrants' Assistance Project. A similar medical mission took place in March 2018, where 115 refugees underwent medical check-ups for resettlement to the USA and Canada.
