

UN Namibia participates in UN For All training



UN Namibia staff members participated in UN Care's "UN for All: Dignity and Inclusion in our Workplace" training throughout the past week.

The training, consisting of two modules, aims to make the United Nations a fully inclusive workplace, which is respectful of all kinds of diversity. The training is held for UN personnel across the globe.

The first module addresses human rights, specifically outlining the basic human rights principles, explaining unconscious bias, introducing basic concepts on diversity and inclusion, and emphasizing the power of language in the creation of an inclusive work environment.

The second module addresses sexual orientation and gender identity, specifically explaining the basics of sexual orientation, gender identity, gender expression and how to include LGBTI personnel in the United Nations.

The training helped UN Namibia personnel to understand how to be more inclusive of all colleagues, and ultimately, how to interact with all the UN's working partners and stakeholders.
